Youth Citizens Police Academy

Why should I attend the YCPA?

Participants will gain firsthand knowledge of their police department and how it functions. It is a chance to both learn and ask questions from officers who specialize in their field.

What type of information will be presented?

Sessions will include a variety of topics that will give the participants an introduction to their police department, education in problem solving, and information about how to make decisions or choices that modern youth face every day.

Presentation topics include the history of the Honolulu Police Department, bullying and cyber bullying, juvenile laws and the criminal justice system, drug awareness, alcohol safety, firearms safety, traffic safety, fitness, etc.

Who attends?

The YCPA is made up of young men and women from our community. Participants will be high school students.

When and Where?

Participants will meet for eight hours a day for three weeks. Two sessions will be conducted at the Honolulu Police Department Alapa'i Headquarters. One session will be conducted at the Training Academy, Ke Kula Maka'i.
